2 Day Dryandra Biodiversity *Accommodated* Tour



Accommodated Small Group Tour - Max 12 passengers

Perth - Perth 13th to 14th September 2021

This tour looks at the forest wildflowers in the foothills around Dwellingup before heading into the Dryandra Woodland Reserve. The Dryandra Woodland offers magnificent woodlands, spectacular wildflowers and is also home to the iconic striped numbat. Over 100 species of birds have been recorded here.

Our journey back to Perth will take us via the historic town of York where we will have time for lunch and a look around the town before driving through the picturesque Avon Valley.

We are only taking a maximum of 12 guests and the trip will be led by a Coates Naturalist Guide who will be on hand to enhance your wildlife experience.

Itinerary

Day 1 Perth - Dryandra - Narrogin

This morning we'll leave Perth around 7.30 am and head south east to Dryandra Woodland. Dryandra is an especially scenic area with magnificent woodlands and spectacular Spring wildflowers. Many interesting eucalypt species and various other flora are found here; it is also of international importance for birds and mammals, the latter including that most exquisite of marsupials, the striped numbat. Although the numbat is probably Dryandra's best known inhabitant, woylies, tammar wallabies, brushtail possums, tawny frogmouths, kangaroos and wallabies are regularly seen by visitors to Dryandra. More than 100 species of bird live in the area. We will spend the afternoon exploring the reserve before enjoying a BBQ dinner and a night stalk. We will finish the day by travelling the short distance to Narrogin and our motel accommodation.

Day 2 Narrogin - York- Perth

This morning we travel to York where we will spend time looking and photographing the wildflowers that can be found along the side of the road. There will be time in York to explore the historic town and to enjoy lunch. Our homeward drive will take us via the Avon Valley arriving back in Perth around 4.00 pm. BL

Trek Grading:

Light bushwalking on both days.

Weather:

Days are usually mild, with temperatures around the mid 20 degrees Celsius. The nights are cooler, with minimum temperatures around 6-12 degrees Celsius. There is also the possibility of light showers during the tour.
